Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope you had a wonderful and relaxing Easter and ready for the final two terms of Year 2! We can't quite believe we are here already! In this letter it will give you an overview of what is going to happen over the next two terms. The attached topic web will give you more information on what is happening in each subject.

Term 5 and 6 Topics:

During Term 5, our topic will be Kenya. Here we are going to explore the continent of Africa and the country Kenya. We are going to imagine what it would be like to go on safari in Kenya and we are going to compare how people live in Kenya to how we live in the UK. Our focus text for this term will be One Day on our Blue Planet: Savannah. The children are going to be learning the key features of a newspaper and they will write a newspaper article about an event in the Savannah.

In Term 4, our topic will be the Sinking of the Titanic. We will explore what was so special about the Titanic, how it sank and the measures put in place to ensure another disaster like the Titanic does not happen again. Our focus text for this term will be The Iron Man. The children will be looking at story writing and they will have a go at writing an alternative ending to the ending in the Iron Man.

Special Agent Training will commence the week of the 15th May 2023 and will take us two weeks to complete. It is vital that your child is in school in the run up to this date and during the two weeks of Special Agent Training.
