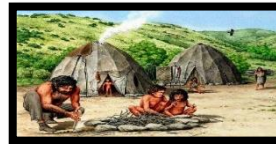
Use fieldwork at Avebury to observe, record and present the human and physical features in the local area using a range of methods, including sketch maps, plans and digital technologies
